



## Volunteer Job Description

General Responsibilities:

The Resident Support Volunteer Driver is responsible for transporting medically fragile and disabled children with their nurse to and from doctor's appointments. Most appointments take place at Children's Hospital.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Drive children with nurse in CCH's wheelchair accessible van to appointments.

Qualifications:

Sensitivity to medically fragile children, ability to speak English, dependability, timeliness. Positive attitude, caring, and patient. If transporting children and nurses, must have current WA driver's license and insurance, have no tickets within the past three years, and be trained to drive the CCH van.

Hours and Compensation:

Hours are variable, usually two to four hours a week on weekdays. This is an unpaid volunteer position that offers the opportunity to provide much needed transportation assistance to the children.
